



What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Germany

Day 2: Frankfurt | Rothenburg

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport
- Travel to Rothenburg
- Take a tour of Rothenburg

Day 3: Munich

- Travel to Munich, where you'll experience the medieval to the modern. During your stay you'll see the Olympic Stadium, BMW headquarters, the fashionable Schwabing district and the Residenz, former home of the Wittelsbach dukes of Bavaria. Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945. It now serves as a memorial museum. In Marienplatz, see the neo-Gothic New City Hall with its famous Glockenspiel. Then continue past the famous Hofbräuhaus, once the royal brewery of the Kingdom of Bavaria.
- Visit Neuschwanstein Castle
- Take a walking tour of Munich: Frauenkirche;
 Neues Rathaus; Hofbräuhaus

Day 4: Munich

- Take an expertly guided tour of Munich:
 Olympic Stadium; Residenz
- Visit Dachau
- Time to see more of Munich or
 - Enjoy a German culture class

Day 5: Venice

- Travel via Innsbruck to Venice, the Floating City crisscrossed with romantic bridges, laced with history and boasting some of the world's finest art and architecture. During your stay you will see gondolas glide down the Grand Canal before stopping in St. Mark's Square. Look for the golden weathervane, which resembles archangel Gabriel, atop the 323-foot Campanile (Bell Tower). At the pink-and-white Doge's Palace, see where mighty Venetian dukes once ruled. Stroll over the Bridge of Sighs, which links the palace to a prison. As they crossed the bridge, prisoners supposedly sighed with perfect sadness as they regarded their beautiful city for the last time.

Day 6: Venice

- Take an expertly guided tour of Venice:
 St. Mark's Square; Grand Canal
- Visit the Doge's Palace
- See a glass-blowing demonstration

Days 7-8: Lucerne

- Travel via Verona to Lucerne, where the majestic Swiss Alps rise behind the shores of Lake Lucerne and provide the stunning backdrop to one of Switzerland's most picturesque cities. While here you'll see the moving Lion Monument, or Löwendenkmal, a sandstone statue commemorating the Swiss Guards slain in the 1792 Paris storming of the Tuileries. Follow Lucerne's winding cobbled streets past fairy-tale houses to the Chapel Bridge, or Kapellbrücke. Stroll along this covered bridge, which dates back to medieval days, and admire the colorful murals overhead.
- Take a tour of Lucerne: Löwendenkmal;
 Kapellbrücke
- Time to see more of Lucerne or
- Visit Mount Pilatus
- Attend a Swiss Folklore Evening

Day 9: Heidelberg

- Travel via Rhine Falls and the Black Forest to Heidelberg
- Take a tour of Heidelberg
- Visit Heidelberg Castle wine barrel

Day 10: Depart for home

- Travel to Strasbourg
- Take an expertly guided tour of Strasbourg
- Visit Strasbourg Cathedral
- Travel by train to Paris

Days 11-12: Paris | Versailles

- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower
- Take an expertly guided tour of Versailles
- Visit the Louvre
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral
