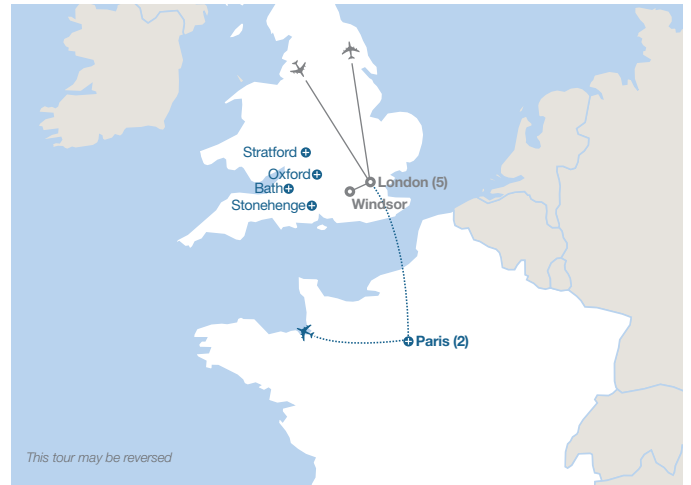

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Take a walking tour of London: The Strand; Trafalgar Square; Leicester Square; Covent Garden
- Enjoy an authentic fish and chips dinner

Day 3: London

- Take an expertly guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled)
- Take an expertly guided tour of Windsor Castle, one of the official residences of the British monarch and currently used for state and private functions. Legend holds that King Arthur's Knights of the Round Table once convened at this former fortress. On your excursion, see priceless objects in the State Apartments, like paintings by Rubens and Holbein as well as Henry VIII's suit of armor. Encounter the Gothic splendor of St. George's Chapel, final resting place of many monarchs including Henry VIII and Charles I. Then, take a look into the miniature world of Queen Mary's Dolls' House, where many of the castle's items are replicated in 1/12th scale. The house even includes a working lighting system and functional plumbing.
- Attend an evening theater performance

Day 4: London

- Full day to see more of London or
 - Visit Stonehenge and Bath: Stonehenge stone circles; Georgian squares of Bath; Roman Baths

Day 5: London

- Visit the Tower of London. Enter through thick defensive walls and take a look behind the Tower of London's imposing stony façade. Henry VIII banished two of his wives to this former prison, where Guy Fawkes also spent his final days. But the Tower's most famous occupants—the Crown Jewels—still reside here today. On your tour, behold this jaw-dropping collection of ornate rings, scepters, swords and royal vestments. Venture outside for a walk through the courtyard, where you can admire the four distinctive turrets rising out of the White Tower. Keep an eye out for the Tower's famous ravens: legend states that the kingdom will fall if any of the six resident ravens ever leaves the Tower Grounds.
- Take a Thames River cruise to Greenwich
- Visit the Royal Observatory
- Visit the National Maritime Museum

Day 6: London

- Full day to see more of London or
 - Visit Oxford and Stratford: Brasenose College; Shakespeare's Birthplace; Gardens at Anne Hathaway's Cottage

Day 7: Depart for home

Day 7: Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris
- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower

Day 8: Paris

- Visit the Louvre
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral

Day 9: Depart for home
