Italy's cities are like museums unto themselves. Rome is full of remnants of the ancient empire, from the Colosseum to the Forum. The Leaning Tower of Pisa saw Galileo test his revolutionary scientific theories. Meanwhile, on the French Riviera, the culture of southern France is in the air—sense it in Nice, in Monaco and at a perfume factory in Eze.

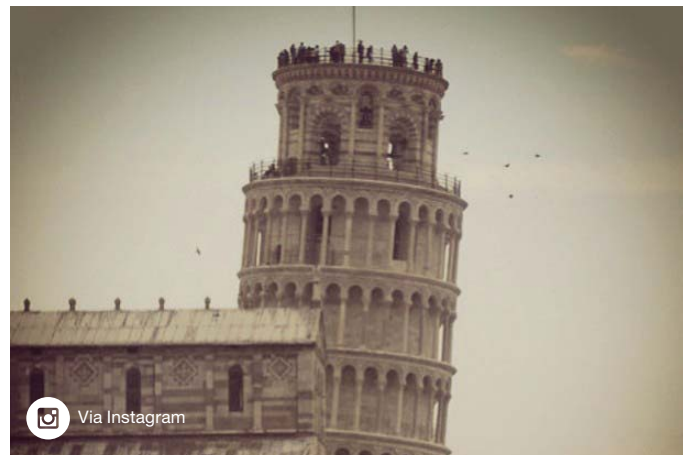

## What you'll experience on your tour

### Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

#### Day 2: Rome

– Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to the Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci," toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.

#### Day 3: Rome

– Take an expertly guided tour of Vatican City  
– Visit the Sistine Chapel  
– Visit St. Peter's Basilica  
– Take an expertly guided tour of Rome  
– Visit the Colosseum  
– Visit the Roman Forum  
– Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome  
– Enjoy a pizza dinner

#### Day 4: Rome

– Full day to see more of Rome or  
• Visit Pompeii

#### Day 5: Florence

– Travel via Siena to Florence, the birthplace of the Italian language, opera and the Renaissance, and where works of art like Michelangelo's statue of David and Botticelli's The Birth of Venus still reside today. As you stroll through the city, pass by classical statues at the Piazza della Signoria. See the domed cap of the Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral, better known as the Duomo, which dominates the skyline. Opposite the Duomo, look for the bronzed doors of Ghiberti's *Gates of Paradise* at the Baptistery. Walk across the Ponte Vecchio, a Medieval bridge where many of Florence's famed leather and gold artisans keep shop. Then, visit a leather workshop, the perfect place to find Florentine souvenirs.

#### Day 6: Florence

– Take an expertly guided tour of Florence: Piazza della Signoria; Ponte Vecchio; Chiesa di Santa Croce; Gates of Paradise  
– Visit the Duomo  
– See a leather-making demonstration

#### Day 7: Pisa | French Riviera

– Travel to Pisa  
– See the Leaning Tower of Pisa  
– Visit the Pisa Baptistery  
– Visit the Pisa Cathedral  
– Continue on to the French Riviera and explore Monaco, a tiny principality that packs wealth, royalty and the world-famous Casino Monte-Carlo into just 0.8 square miles. Here you'll see the Cathédrale de Monaco, where Prince Rainier wed movie star Grace Kelly, a union that ultimately sparked an influx of Hollywood stars and starlets to the French Riviera. Take a walking tour of Nice, strolling down the palm-lined Promenade des Anglais and getting a taste of the Old Town. Soak up the scenery, from the white-washed villas to the flower market to the emerald waters that lap Nice's endless beaches.

#### Day 8: Monaco | French Riviera

– Visit the principality of Monaco  
– Tour a French perfume factory in Eze  
– Take a walking tour of Nice
