Scholarship Contest Berlin 2012

Terms & Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

No purchase necessary. This Global Citizen Scholarship contest to Berlin is open to U.S. residents who are currently freshmen, sophomores or juniors in high school and 14 to 17 years of age at the time of entry. Employees, directors, officers and principals of EF Educational Tours ("COMPANY"), its subsidiaries, affiliates, contractors, agents and members of their immediate families or households are not eligible to participate.. This Sweepstakes is void where prohibited by law.

2. HOW TO ENTER

Visit apps.facebook.com/ef tours/globalcitizen to read the rules and link to the actual contest, which is being hosted on Facebook. Students can also submit their applications through Facebook or via email to education.department@ef.com. All entries completed correctly will be eligible to enter in the Global Citizen Scholarship contest to Berlin.

3. PROMOTION PERIOD

The contest starts on 12:00 a.m. Eastern Standard Time on November 1, 2011 and ends at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on January 31, 2012 (the "Promotion Period"). All entries must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. on January 31, 2012. Students who submit complete projects between November 1, 2011 and December 15, 2011 will be eligible to win an iPad. The strongest project (as reviewed using the project rubric and input from EF selection team) will win the iPad prize. Limit one entry per person. All entries submitted become the sole property of EF Educational Tours and will not be returned. After projects have been submitted, EF reserves the right to share projects publicly through the EF Educational Tours website, Facebook page and other channels at the sole discretion of EF. Entries generated by a script, macro or other automated means are prohibited and will be automatically disqualified.

4. SELECTION OF WINNERS

The selection of winners will be conducted by a panel of judges within the COMPANY. This selection will take place on or before April 1, 2012. All decisions are final.

5. PRIZE

Annually, 15-20 high school students (current freshmen, sophomores or juniors) who exemplify the qualities of a Global Citizen are awarded scholarships. Recipients will be high school students who are devoted to promoting global awareness. Recipients will join peers from across the country on a June 2012 journey to explore the topic of global citizenship in Berlin, Germany. In order to participate on the tour to Germany, all recipients must complete the EF Tours application which includes a Release and Agreement. EF Tours reserves the right to disqualify any winner prior to the tour if they do not continue to exemplify the qualities of a Global Citizen or if, in EF's sole discretion, their participation on the tour would no longer be appropriate.

6. GENERAL CONDITIONS

This contest is governed by the laws of the United States. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. This contest is void where prohibited by law. Winners will be notified by e-mail or telephone and may be required to sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release of Publicity and Liability within 14 days of notification. In the event of noncompliance, if the winner cannot be reached at the e-mail address or telephone number submitted with entry, or if the prize or prize notification is returned as unclaimed or undeliverable, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner will be selected. No cash alternative or substitution of any prizes will be offered.
