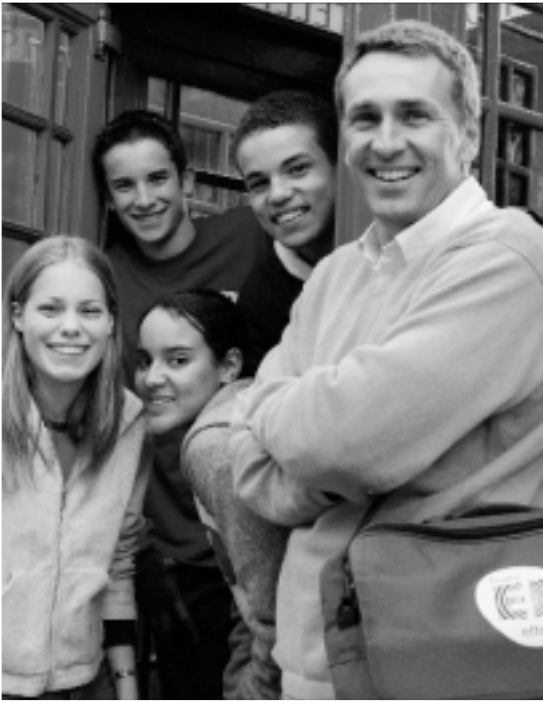




# Earn credits while you travel with EF!



Through a unique partnership with Eastern Washington University, EF is able to offer group leaders and student travelers the opportunity to earn valuable academic credit while traveling on an EF Educational Tour or an EF Explore America Tour. Earning academic credit with EWU enhances every part of the educational experience—before, during, and after your EF tour. All courses are from accredited academic institutions. Credits are fully transferable and will be documented on an official transcript.

### EF's commitment to professional growth for group leaders

- Earning credits through Eastern Washington University is a great way for teachers to maintain their professional development requirements and enrich their careers.
- Group leaders can choose graduate-level courses that match their travel itinerary from the departments of: education, fine arts, social sciences, or customize a program with Eastern Washington University.

### High school and college credit for student travelers

- Students can supplement their formal high school and future academic needs with EF and Eastern Washington University experiential learning opportunities.
- Students have the opportunity to earn transferable academic credits in conjunction with their educational tours, which can be included on scholarship and college applications.
- Students can choose high school-level courses that match their EF travel itineraries from the following academic departments: humanities/fine arts, social science, language arts, service learning, or customize a program with Eastern Washington University.
- Student travelers can choose introductory-level university courses that match their travel itinerary from the departments of: history, fine arts, journalism, social sciences, or customize a program with Eastern Washington University.

## Eastern Washington University's Eisenhower Center

Eastern Washington University's Eisenhower Center was established to provide students and teachers who are participating in educational travel programs with the opportunity to increase their understanding and tolerance of foreign people and places, develop confidence in themselves as world observers, and expand their appreciation of education as their vital partner in achieving future goals.

### Credit, tuition and book fees

- University credits earned are resident "quarter-system" credits and will appear on an official transcript (EWU or affiliate). For details regarding transferring credit, contact the college or university you plan to transfer credit to.
- Credit will not be granted unless the student successfully completes both the academic and travel phases of the program. Refunds will not be granted once the student is officially registered for coursework, unless the student's travel program has been canceled by EF. Eastern Washington University will make the final determination on matters in question.
- Tuition fee is \$75 per high school credit and \$93 per college credit payable to Eastern Washington University.
- Some courses require the International Field Study Workbook (\$15). Only one workbook per student is required, regardless of the number of courses taken. If necessary to the course, a separate check, made payable to IFS Book Center, should be included with the tuition fee.
- After course registration has been processed by Eastern Washington University's Eisenhower Center, the student will receive course materials by mail.
- Courses are offered on the Pass Credit/No Credit option. If a letter grade is required, a written request must be made to the Eastern Washington University office prior to overseas departure of the EF tour.
