BERLIN & PRAGUE

8 or 11 days | Germany | Czech Republic

Delve into Eastern Europe's past, present and future. Begin with visits to the Checkpoint Charlie Museum and the Reichstag in Berlin. Make your way through cosmopolitan Dresden before arriving in Prague, also known as the City of One Hundred Spires. Here, cap off your journey with a walk down the Golden Lane.

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Germany

Days 2: Berlin

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany. The city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now plays a vital role in the European Union. During your stay you'll visit the Checkpoint Charlie museum, named after the checkpoint station that once guarded the border between East and West Germany. Here you can see escape cars, hot air balloons and even a submarine—all used in risky border crossings. Stroll past cafés, restaurants and embassies along Unter den Linden, Berlin's most elegant boulevard. Continue to the imposing Reichstag building, the historical seat of Germany's parliament.
- Take a walking tour of Berlin: Unter den Linden; Reichstag

Day 3: Berlin

- Take a guided tour of Berlin: Brandenburg Gate; Kurfürstendamm; Remains of Berlin Wall
- Visit Checkpoint Charlie Museum
- Visit the DDR Museum
- Take a river cruise (March-October)

Day 4: Berlin

- Visit the Story of Berlin exhibit
- Enjoy free time in Berlin
- Time to explore on your own or [Potsdam](#)

Day 5: Dresden | Prague

- Travel to Dresden where, against all odds, the city's striking beauty endures. Trace the history of the Saxon capital during your stay, and gain insight into the effects of the devastating firebombing of World War II and the city's subsequent reconstruction. Pass the stately Semper Opera House, which debuted many of Wagner's operas. See the statue of Martin Luther, initiator of the Protestant Reformation and translator of the Bible into the language of the people. You'll also have free time to explore the magnificent Zwinger Palace and Museum. With its dramatic spires and vaulted eaves, this Eastern European treasure is a stunning exemplar of Baroque architecture.
- Take a guided walking tour of Dresden
- Enjoy free time in Dresden
- Travel to Prague

Day 6: Prague

- Enjoy your final two days on tour in Prague, where you'll encounter the legendary beauty of the former capital of the Holy Roman Empire. Located on the Vltava River, Prague gracefully balances the classical features of old Europe with a lively, Bohemian spirit. During your stay you'll pass the concert hall where Mozart conducted the premiere of Don Giovanni. Walk the quaint, cobbled streets of the Mala Strana and visit the 13th-century Stare Mesto (Old Town) and Market Square. Here you'll see the famous 15th-century astronomical clock. From St. Vitus Cathedral to the Baroque statues of the Charles Bridge, you'll explore the celebrated art and architecture of the City of One Hundred Spires.
