Itinerary

June 19—29, 2015

Days 1—2: Budapest

Fly overnight to Budapest, where you'll meet your Tour Director at the airport. Then, take a walking tour of Budapest: Fisherman's Bastion; Parliament.

Day 3: Budapest

Join your local guide for a deep exploration of the sights and sounds of Budapest. Then, meet with students in a local school and experience a day in the life of a Hungarian student. Find out firsthand how education in Hungary compares and contrasts to ours in the United States.

Day 4: Budapest/Prague

Travel to Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia, and take a walking tour of the city. Explore Bratislava's rich cultural and historical heritage as you stroll through the Old Town and visit the city's castle. Then, continue to Prague.

Day 5: Prague

Experience Prague's history and beauty as you walk across the historic Charles Bridge and visit the "city of one hundred spires." Then, visit CERGE, the Center for Economic Research and Graduate Education, an institution that provides an American-style PhD program in economics. Attend a lecture and gain a deeper understanding of how CERGE teaches Central and Eastern European students the modern western standards of economic instruction and scientific work.

Day 6: Prague/Munich

Travel to Munich, where you will be introduced to the city on a bike tour. As you pedal your way through the metropolis, you'll see why it's known as the city of "laptops and lederhosen," a nod to its ability to remain at the forefront

of technological developments while maintaining its cultural heritage.

Day 7: Munich

Your Tour Director will get you up close and personal with the sights of Munich, from the Olympic Stadium to Marienplatz. Then, participate in one of EF's International Language School classes to learn about the latest experiential language learning techniques and practice some German. After the class you'll hit the streets of Munich and use your newly minted German vocabulary in a friendly competition around the city.

Day 8: Munich/Davos

Travel to Liechtenstein. Then, continue on to Davos, Switzerland, home of the World Economic Forum's annual meeting, where business and political leaders

discuss the world's most pressing issues. Get warmed up for the Student Leadership Conference this evening with a team-building activity.

Days 9—10: Davos

The **leadership conference** begins as you connect with students from all over the world in this inspiring and innovative setting. Over the course of two days you will hear from world-renowned keynote speakers, work with local and global experts, and collaborate with peers in small international teams. You will be taught the design thinking process to develop solutions to some of the largest challenges we face and be inspired to take action back home.

Day 11: Depart for home
