What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Scotland

Days 2: Glasgow | Edinburgh region

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport
- Travel to Edinburgh, where Edinburgh Castle is the enduring symbol of Scotland's capital and site of many of the nation's storied events. Ownership of the fortress, perched atop an extinct volcano, changed hands many times over the centuries, from Scottish to English and back again. Mary, Queen of Scots, gave birth here to James VI of Scotland, who would later rule England as James I. In addition to the castle, you'll see the homes of Alexander Graham Bell and Robert Louis Stevenson. For a sense of what it was like to live in Edinburgh in centuries past, stroll down the Royal Mile through the Old Town, a romantic jumble of medieval buildings.

Day 3: Edinburgh region

- Take a guided tour of Edinburgh
- Visit Edinburgh Castle

Day 4: Edinburgh region | Chester

- Visit the Housesteads Fort
- Travel through the Lake District to Chester

Day 5: Chester | London

- Take a tour of Chester
- Take a tour of Stratford
- Visit Shakespeare's birthplace
- Visit the gardens at Anne Hathaway's Cottage
- Continue on to London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.

Day 6: London

- Take a guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled)
- Time to explore more of London or
 - Visit Windsor Castle
- Enjoy a fish and chips dinner

Day 7: London | Paris

- Take a walking tour of London: Trafalgar Square; Covent Garden
- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa. Then, admire the Notre Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.

Day 8: Paris

- Take a guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Eiffel Tower
- Time to explore more of Paris or
 - Visit Versailles

Day 9: Paris

- Visit the Louvre
- Take a walking tour of Paris
- Visit the Latin Quarter
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral

Day 10: Depart for home

Days 10-11: Normandy | Paris

- Visit the Caen Memorial
- Visit the D-Day beaches of Normandy
- Visit the American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer
