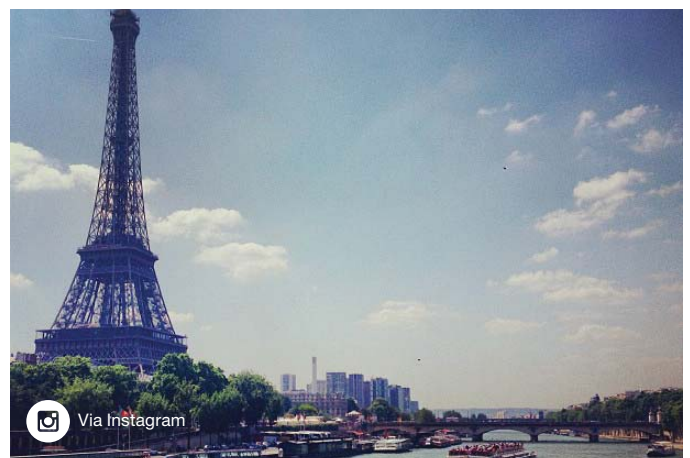

## What you'll experience on your tour

### Day 1: Fly overnight to France

#### Day 2: Paris

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa. Then, admire the Notre Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Opéra district; Place Vendôme; Rue du Faubourg St. Honoré; Tuileries
- Visit the Louvre

#### Day 3: Paris

- Take a guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower; Conciergerie
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral
- Time to explore on your own or [+ Versailles](#)

#### Day 4: Brussels | Amsterdam

- Travel via Brussels
- Continue on to Amsterdam, a city where 1,200 bridges crisscross 160 canals to make it one of Europe's most charming capitals. During your stay you'll see the Westerkerk (West Church), where Rembrandt is buried. You'll also visit Dam Square, which is home to Koninklijk Paleis (the Royal Palace), before seeing the Flower Market and Jewish Quarter. Visit the Anne Frank House, where the young girl hid with her family from 1942 to 1944. This is also the site where she penned her poignant diary, which has been translated into dozens of languages worldwide.
- Take a walking tour of Amsterdam: City canals

#### Day 5: Amsterdam

- Take a guided tour of Amsterdam: Dam Square and Koninklijk Paleis; Westerkerk; Flower Market; Jewish Quarter
- Visit the Anne Frank House
- Time to explore on your own or [+ Volendam and Zaanse Schans](#)

#### Day 6: Hamburg

- Travel to Hamburg
- Take a tour of Hamburg

#### Day 7: Copenhagen

- Travel to Copenhagen, Hans Christian Andersen's fairy-tale city. During your stay you'll pass by Tivoli Gardens (the city's lively amusement park), Christiansborg Palace (seat of the Danish Parliament) and the Royal Theatre (home of the famous Royal Danish Ballet). Stop at the royal residence Amalienborg before seeing the statue of the fabled Little Mermaid, who watches over the harbor. You'll also have a chance to walk through Old Copenhagen and climb the 17th-century Round Tower, Europe's oldest functioning observatory. A winding, 685-foot staircase links the tower to a church and library, which now serve as a concert and exhibition hall. See if you can make out the gilded inscription penned by King Christian IV high atop the façade.
- Take a walking tour of Copenhagen: Old Town; City Hall Square
- Visit the Round Tower

#### Day 8: Copenhagen

- Take a guided tour of Copenhagen: Tivoli Gardens; Christiansborg Palace; Little Mermaid
- Time to explore on your own or [+ Kronborg Castle in Elsinore](#)
