## What you'll experience on your tour

### Day 1: Fly overnight to England

#### Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Take a walking tour of London: Piccadilly Circus; Trafalgar Square; The Strand; Covent Garden
- Visit the National Gallery

#### Day 3: London

- Take an expertly guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Westminster Abbey
- Visit the Tower of London
- Attend an evening theater performance

#### Day 4: Normandy

- Travel to Dover
- Visit Dover Castle and WWII Tunnels
- Travel by ferry to Calais

#### Day 5: Normandy

- Visit the Caen Memorial
- Take an expertly guided tour of the D-Day beaches of Normandy: American Cemetery; Arromanches; Pointe du Hoc

#### Day 6: Paris

- Travel to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Then, admire the Notre Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.
- Visit the Louvre
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral

#### Day 7: Paris

- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Eiffel Tower
- Take an expertly guided tour of Versailles

#### Day 8: Paris | Night train

- Enjoy a free day in Paris
- Travel by night train to Florence

#### Day 9: Florence

- Take an expertly guided tour of Florence: Ponte Vecchio; Gates of Paradise
- Visit the Duomo
- Visit the Accademia

#### Day 10: Rome

- Travel to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to the Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci," toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.

- Visit the Sistine Chapel
