Days 1-3: Barcelona

Meet your Tour Director in Barcelona. From setting new trends in learning technology to putting a molecular spin on traditional cuisine, the city's innovative drive and passion for expression form a creative culture all its own. Get a feel for Mediterranean scenery, bustling urban energy, and mountain peaks as you stroll through Barcelona. Hop on your bicycle for a ride through openair plazas dotted with avant-garde gems and Modernist mosaics. On your visit to the Museum of Ideas and Inventions, get a unique glimpse into inventive—and sometimes absurd—trends in modern innovation. Then, classic Spanish ingredients meet modern cooking techniques as you try your hand at a molecular gastronomy workshop.



Day 4-6: Madrid

Board your AVE train—Spain's first high-speed railway—to Madrid, the capital and largest city in Spain. Journey to Toledo, the former Spanish capital, where you'll experience the Cathedral of Toledo and the Church of Santo Tomé. During a market challenge, you'll interact with local vendors and try traditional Spanish foods. Cap off your time in Madrid with a tour of Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, home of the Real Madrid soccer team.

Days 7-9: Berlin

Fly to Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany. The city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now is one of the world's most attractive tech hubs-where a new start-up is founded every 20 minutes and an untraditional "give-it-a-go" atmosphere allows space for exciting and risky ideas. Explore the city with an expert local guide and see the contrast of old and new everywhere, as Baroque buildings sit beside contemporary skyscrapers and quaint cafes, where entrepreneurs meet to brainstorm. Celebrate the power of ideas during activities hosted by social and technological innovators.

At the East Side Gallery, a piece of the Berlin Wall that spans almost a mile was painted in 1990 just after the fall of East Germany, marking the end of the Cold War. As you hone your creative skills during a street art tour and workshop, consider how Berlin's culture of adaptability, expression, and the drive to improve inspired artists and tech enthusiasts alike.

Days 10-11: Summit Conference

The leadership conference officially begins as you connect with students from all around North America and Europe in this inspiring and innovative setting. Over the course of two days you will hear from world-renowned keynote speakers, work with local and global experts, and collaborate with peers in small international teams. You will learn the design thinking process to develop solutions focusing on the Influence of Technology on Society and be inspired to take action back home.

Day 12: Depart for home

Head to the airport and arrive back home, prepared to join the movement.
