

Days 1-4: Helsinki | Night ferry

Meet your Tour Director in Helsinki, the capital of Finland and home to innovative tech companies, like mobile phone maker Nokia, that inspire the region's entrepreneurial spirit and creativity. Aside from being a hotspot for innovation and the center for new trends in European technology, Finland also earned its title as the world's top-ranked education system, according to a 2012 report by the Programme for International Student Assessment. As you explore Helsinki on foot, you'll see why the area was voted the World Design Capital of 2012. Discover the city's most famous landmarks before visiting Temppeliaukio Church. Also known as the Church of the Rock, this iconic landmark was built directly out of one, and boasts natural sunlight through its glazed dome. Cap off your stay with an excursion to Suomenlinna, an inhabited sea fortress and UNESCO World Heritage Site. From here, board your overnight ferry to Stockholm.



Days 5-6: Stockholm

Arrive in Stockholm, Sweden's capital city, known for realizing the full potential of students through the application of digital learning innovations like tablets and smart gadgets, gamification, and cloud-based learning systems. While exploring the city on foot, your local guide will introduce you to Stockholm's impressive architecture and rich history as you take in Old Town, the Royal Opera House, Parliament, the Royal Palace, and the oldest church in Stockholm—dating from 1306. Take time to explore the Swedish capital at your leisure before your flight to Berlin.

Days 7-9: Berlin

Fly to Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany. The city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now is one of the world's most attractive tech hubs—where a new start-up is founded every 20 minutes and an untraditional "give-it-a-go" atmosphere allows space for exciting and risky ideas. See the contrast of old and new everywhere on your guided sightseeing tour—Baroque buildings sit beside contemporary skyscrapers and quaint cafes where entrepreneurs meet to brainstorm. Celebrate the power of ideas during activities hosted by social and technological innovators. As you hone your creative skills during a street art tour and workshop, consider how Berlin's culture of adaptability, expression, and the drive to improve inspired artists and tech enthusiasts alike.

Days 10-11: Summit Conference

The leadership conference officially begins as you connect with students from all around North America and Europe in this inspiring and innovative setting. Over the course of two days you will hear from world-renowned keynote speakers, work with local and global experts, and collaborate with peers in small international teams. You will learn the design thinking process to develop solutions focusing on the Influence of Technology on Society and be inspired to take action back home.

Day 12: Depart for home

Head to the airport and arrive back home, prepared to join the movement.
