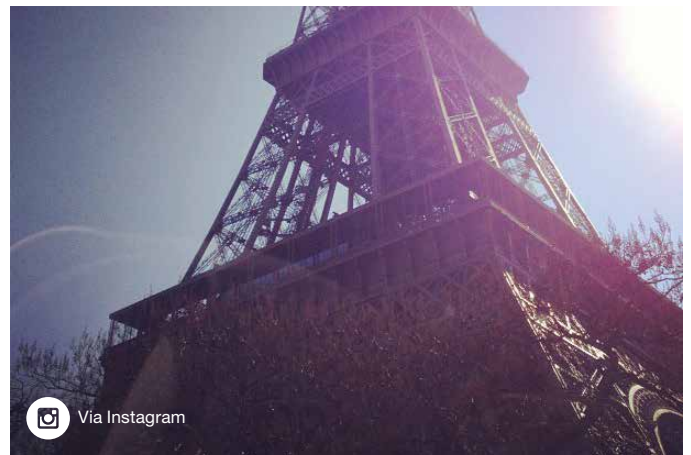

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Days 2-4: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Take a guided tour of London
- Time to see more of London or
 - Visit Windsor Castle
- Enjoy a fish and chips dinner

Days 5-7: Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Then, admire the Notre Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade.

- Time to see more of Paris or
 - Visit Versailles

Day 8: Paris | Brussels | Amsterdam

- Travel to Brussels
- Continue to Amsterdam
- Take a walking tour of Amsterdam

Day 9: Amsterdam

- Visit the Anne Frank House
- Time to see more of Amsterdam or
 - Volendam and Zaanse Schans

Day 10: Heidelberg

- Take a tour of Heidelberg
- Visit Heidelberg Castle wine barrel

Days 11-12: Lucerne

- Travel via the Black Forest
- Take a tour of Lucerne
- Time to see more of Lucerne or
 - Mount Pilatus

Day 13: Lucerne | Munich

- Visit Neuschwanstein Castle
- Travel to Munich

Day 14: Munich

- Take a guided tour of Munich
- Visit Dachau
- Take a walking tour of Munich

Day 15: Salzburg | Munich

- Visit the salt mines in Salzburg

Days 16-17: Venice

- Travel via Innsbruck to Venice
- Take a guided tour of Venice
- Visit the Doge's Palace
- See a glass-blowing demonstration

Days 18-19: Florence

- Take a guided tour of Florence
- Visit the Duomo

Days 20-21: Assisi | Rome

- Visit the Basilica of St. Francis
- Travel to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to the Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci," toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.
- Take a guided tour of Vatican City: Sistine Chapel; St. Peter's Basilica
- Take a guided tour of Rome: Colosseum; Roman Forum
- Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome

Days 22-23: Sorrento | Night Ferry

- Visit the Roman ruins of Pompeii
- Board a night ferry to Greece

Days 24-28: Meteora | Delphi | Athens

- Visit a Meteora monastery
- Take a guided tour of Delphi
- Take a guided tour of Athens
- Visit the Acropolis and Acropolis Museum
- Time to see more of Athens or
 - Greek Evening
- Depart for home
