

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, where you'll experience cutting-edge science and technology.
- Take a walking tour of London, where you'll see iconic sites such as the Strand, Trafalgar Square, Leicester Square, and Covent Garden.

Day 3: London

- Take an expertly guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled).
- Straddle both hemispheres at the Royal Observatory in Greenwich, where a laser beam marks the Prime Meridian.
- Attend a show at the Peter Harrison Planetarium, London's only planetarium. Learn about black holes and find out how to interpret the stars in the night sky.
- At the Emirates Aviation Experience, explore modern aircraft technology and operations, and take in 360° degree views.
- Enjoy an authentic fish and chips dinner.

Day 4: London | Bath region

- Visit Avebury.
- Visit Stonehenge, the United Kingdom's most mysterious landmark. This configuration of massive boulders seems to rise out of nowhere on the misty hills of Wiltshire. Legend holds that Merlin built this ring of stones, and many remain captivated by accounts of Stonehenge's supernatural origins. On your tour, go beyond the conspiracy theories and unwrap the mysteries that continue to plague scientists and historians today: who created Stonehenge? How did they erect the fourton stones? And, most importantly, why was it built? While the purpose of Stonehenge remains unknown, many suspect that this 4,000-year-old landmark once served as an ancient temple and astronomical observatory.
- Visit Salisbury Cathedral.
- Travel to Bath region.

Day 5: Bath | Plymouth region

- Take an expertly guided tour of Bath: Georgian squares.
- Visit the Roman Baths.
- Travel to Plymouth region.

Day 6: Plymouth region

- Visit the Eden Project, the world's largest greenhouse. Travel into a crater 50 meters deep to witness this ambitious environmental venture just few miles from the town of St. Blazey in Cornwall. Massive geodesic structures appear to bubble out of the ground, forming a complex of giant hemispheres containing plants from around the world. Each individual biome adjusts to suit its plant's natural weather conditions. You'll have the chance to explore The Core, a three-floor educational center with rotating entertainment events that include talks, workshops, and even concerts. Check out exhibits and displays that offer everyday tips and techniques for leading a more sustainable life.
- Stop at the Mayflower Steps Arch.

Day 7: Plymouth region | London

- Return to London.
- Enjoy free time to explore the city at your own pace.

Day 8: London

- Visit the Science Museum, where you can save a model city from a blackout in a game that simulates real-life power outages. From Watson and Crick's 3D molecular DNA model to a massive x-ray telescope that mapped our galaxy, learn about some of history's greatest scientific discoveries.
