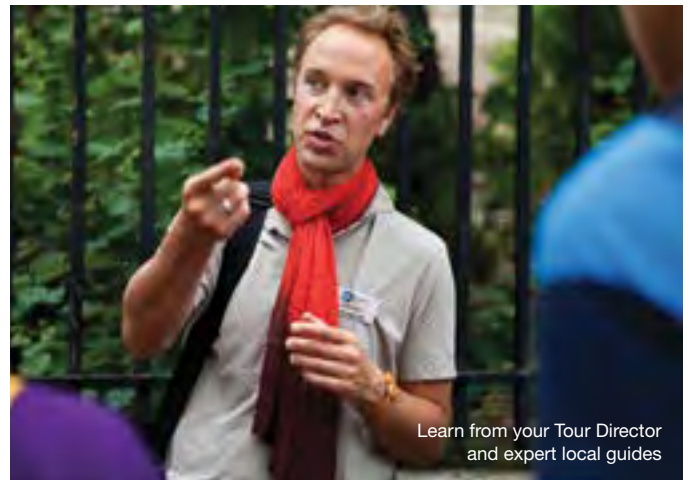

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Days 2-4: London | Night ferry

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.
- From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn during your walking tour of the city.
- During your expertly guided tour of London you'll admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Travel by night ferry to Holland.

Days 5-6: Amsterdam

- Take an expertly guided tour of Amsterdam.
- Visit the Anne Frank House.
- Time to see more of Amsterdam or [visit Volendam and Zaanse Schans](#).

Day 7: Brussels

- Take a tour of Brussels.

Days 8-9: Paris

- Travel to Paris, the City of Light.
- Get a taste of Parisian style on your walking tour of the city.
- Visit the Louvre and explore art from around the world as you wander from wing to wing of one of Paris's biggest attractions and the most visited museum in the world. Built to defend the city in the 13th century, today the Louvre safeguards collections that span continents and the ages.
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral to admire its sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows, and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.
- Ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power.
- Time to see more of Paris or [visit Versailles](#).

Days 10-11: Heidelberg

- Take a tour of Heidelberg.
- Visit the Heidelberg Castle wine barrel.

Days 12-13: Munich | Tyrol

- Visit Neuschwanstein Castle.
- Take a walking tour of Munich.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Munich.
- Visit Dachau.

Days 14-15: Florence

- Take an expertly guided tour of Florence.
- Visit the Duomo.
- Time to see more of Florence or [visit Pisa](#).

Days 16-17: Rome

- Travel to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.
- Take an expertly guided tour of the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat, and the Roman Forum, the former heart of the Roman Empire where Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches.
- Be sure to look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard as you explore Vatican City on an expertly guided tour.
- Marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling on your visit to the Sistine Chapel.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica.
