Step back in time to learn how these cities fostered so many of history's most accomplished composers, tour Mozart's birthplace and the home of the harmonious von Trapp family, and experience the emotive power of Viennese music for yourself.

Day 7: Innsbruck | Davos

Take advantage of a few hours in Innsbruck on your way to Davos. Grab a bite to eat or wander around the charming city center before crossing the border into Switzerland. Located in Graubünden, Davos is the innovative mountainside town where your three-day leadership conference will take place.

Days 1–4: Vienna

Fly overnight to Vienna and meet your Tour Director before beginning your journey in a city whose artistic legacy was shaped by famed residents like Beethoven. During a guided tour, you'll visit places like the Ringstrasse, the flower-adorned City Hall, and the Hofburg, where the Habsburg dynasty once ruled. See where Marie Antoinette spent her childhood when you tour the 1,441room Schönbrunn Palace, and discover the complex relationship between Vienna and dance during a traditional Austrian waltz lesson. Encounter music as never before at Vienna's Haus der Musik, where you can conduct the Vienna Philharmonic from a virtual conductor's podium, watch a violin maker at work, and more. Fittingly, you'll round out your time in the music capital of the world at a local concert.

Days 5-6: Salzburg

Spend a final morning in Vienna participating in an activity centered around *The Power of Communication* before traveling to Salzburg, where you'll tour Mozart's birthplace. Renowned for its baroque architecture, Salzburg was also home to the von Trapps. See where scenes for *The Sound of Music* were filmed in 1964 and learn more about how the family fled Austria and the Nazi regime in 1938. While in Salzburg, you'll ride a funicular from the heart of Old Town up to Hohensalzburg Fortress: the city's most visible landmark and one of Europe's largest castles.

Days 8–10: Leadership Conference

Enjoy a scenic cable car ride and a bit of free time to explore Davos before the conference kicks off on Friday night. You'll engage in some friendly competition with other Summit attendees, and be encouraged to step outside your comfort zone as you get to know the team you will work with over the next few days. On Saturday, the leadership conference continues as you collaborate with students from across North America and the world in this inspiring setting. Over the course of the entire weekend, you'll hear from world-renowned speakers, converse with local and global experts, and work in small international teams to harness *The Power of Communication*. The event will strengthen your creativity and critical thinking skills as you use design thinking to develop solutions that improve the way the world communicates.

Day 11: Depart for home

Head to the Zurich airport ready to address local challenges and initiate meaningful conversations back home.
