Why Switzerland and Germany?

On this tour, discover how Germany is leading the way when it comes to renewable energy technology—with Switzerland following closely behind. Using the sustainable choices of these Alpine advocates as an example, you'll consider what energy sources the world should be using, and learn how to maintain a productive dialogue around this critical topic when you return home.

Days 1-2: Zurich | Davos

Fly overnight to Zurich and meet your Tour Director before traveling to Davos, the innovative mountainside town where your three-day leadership conference will take place.

Days 3-5: Leadership Conference

Enjoy a scenic cable car ride and a bit of free time to explore Davos before the conference kicks off on Friday night. You'll engage in some friendly competition with other Summit attendees, and be encouraged to step outside your comfort zone as you get to know the team you will work with over the next few days. On Saturday, the leadership conference continues as you collaborate with students from across North America and the world in this inspiring setting. Over the course of the entire weekend, you'll hear from world-renowned speakers, converse with local and global experts, and work in small international teams to harness *The Power of Communication*. The event will strengthen your creativity and critical thinking skills as you use design thinking to develop solutions that improve the way the world communicates.

Days 6-7: Lucerne

With all you learned at the Summit in mind, arrive in Lucerne, a picturesque city where you can begin investigating the connections between STEM systems and communication across the world. During your time in central Switzerland, you'll learn about renewable energy and take a guided tour of the Grimsel Power Plant. Follow Lucerne's winding cobbled streets to the Kapellbrücke, Europe's oldest wooden covered bridge. You'll see the poignant Lion Monument, which commemorates the Swiss Guards slain in the 1792 Paris storming of the Tuileries, and journey to the top of Mount Pilatus—the 6,387-foot peak that towers over Lucerne.

Days 8-9: Freiburg

Cross into Germany to spend time at the Innovation Academy and learn firsthand about the region's many innovations in renewable energy, solar power, and ecological agriculture. The sunniest city in Deutschland, Freiburg is a hub for solar energy. Built as a sustainable model district, Vauban uses solar energy to power many of its households. Explore this eco-city on a guided tour before venturing into the dense woods of the Black Forest, where you'll find yourself in a fairy tale come to life.



Days 10-11: Heidelberg

Spend a final morning in Freiburg participating in an activity centered around *The Power of Communication* before traveling to Heidelberg. You'll arrive in the lush foothills of the Neckar Valley in time for dinner. Numerous Nobel Prize winners and philosophers studied here, establishing Heidelberg as Germany's premier university city. Travel along medieval streets lined with peaked red roofs on your sightseeing tour. Ride a funicular up to Heidelberg Castle and see the stunning views that inspired Goethe, as well as a statue dedicated to the poet in the gardens. This portion of your tour also includes a solar boat cruise with your group.

Day 12: Depart for home

Head to the Frankfurt airport ready to address local challenges and initiate meaningful conversations back home.


