ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION


- Contribute to meaningful service projects that will have a positive environmental impact on the local area

6-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive in Santiago

Meet your Tour Director at the airport and travel to your accommodations in Jarabacoa to settle in. This mountain town is rich in biodiversity, and you'll quickly see why it's a fitting setting for your Earth Month experience.

Day 2: Jarabacoa

- Travel to El Instituto del Ambiente, the Dominican Republic's foremost institution addressing sustainable land management, agriculture, conservation, and reforestation.
- Attend a keynote address on the importance of local and global actions against climate change.
- Take a campus walking tour of El Instituto del Ambiente and learn about the various projects you'll work on.
- Meet your service project teammates, participate in a safety briefing, and begin your service project work.
- Enjoy a welcome dinner in Jarabacoa with your new collaborators.

Day 3: Service Project-Jarabacoa

- You and your team will continue your environmental sustainability service projects at El Instituto del Ambiente.
- Experience a different form of teamwork on a whitewater rafting excursion.
 Afterward, relax and swim in the Yaque del Norte River.
- Reflect, discuss the day's events as a group, and draw connections between the work you're doing and global environmental issues.
- After dinner, take a Caribbean dance lesson, where you'll learn styles like bachata and merengue.

Day 4: Service Project-Jarabacoa

- Continue working with your team on your environmentally-focused service project at El Instituto del Ambiente.
- Hike to one of the region's premier waterfalls and experience its beauty close-up.
- Engage in reflection activities with your group about your service project work, the local community you're exploring, and environmental issues you're noticing.

Day 5: Service Project-Jarabacoa

- Spend your last morning collaborating with your team to finish your service work.
- Participate in a workshop hosted by a local non-profit to learn how to initiate meaningful conversations to address environmental challenges in your own community.
- Share the impact and final outcome of your service project work with all Earth Month participants.
- Wrap up your Earth Month experience by hearing from a closing keynote speaker about the long-term change you have the ability to make.
- Celebrate your accomplishments during a farewell dinner.

Day 6: Depart for home

Head to the airport with more knowledge of the skills needed to take action against climate change back home.

Your experience includes: 5 overnight stays in hotels; round-trip flights on major carriers; dinner on day 1; breakfast, lunch, and dinner on days 2–5; breakfast on day 6; local ground transportation; full-time Tour Director; sustainable service projects; service hours that count towards academic credit; dance lesson; whitewater rafting; waterfall hike
