What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.
- Take a walking tour of London: The Strand;
 Trafalgar Square; Leicester Square;
 Covent Garden.

Day 3: London

- During your expertly guided tour of London, admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Time to see more of London or
- visit Windsor Castle.

Day 4: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter.
- Visit the Louvre. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to this renowned museum, which is home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.
- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral to admire its sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows, and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.

Day 5: Paris

- During your expertly guided tour of the city, you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques.
 Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or
- visit Versailles.

Day 6: Paris | Flight to Rome

- Enjoy free time this morning to explore Paris on your own.
- Fly to Rome.

Day 7: Rome

- Take an expertly guided tour of Vatican City.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel to experience its breathtaking domed ceiling. From Michelangelo's frescos to Raphael's tapestries, Pope Sixtus IV commissioned the masters of the day to cover nearly every inch of the chapel in art depicting important Biblical scenes. For a very special keepsake, drop a postcard in the mail before you go, complete with a stamp from the world's smallest country.
- Visit to St. Peter's Basilica. Be sure to look for the papal protectors who flank its entrance: they're the highly trained soldiers of Vatican City's Pontifical Swiss Guard. Inside, pass under gilded archways lofted hundreds of feet off the ground before heading to visit the saint's tomb.
- Time to see more of Rome or
- take a cooking class.

Day 8: Rome

- Take an expertly guided tour of Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other.
- Visit the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat.
- Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome: Trevi Fountain; Pantheon; Piazza Navona; Spanish Steps.
