9 or 12 days | Quito | Tena | Riobamba | Guayaquil | Extension to Puerto López

From towering waterfalls to dreamy cloud forests, Ecuador is where Mother Nature did some of her best work. In this lush South American sanctuary, nestled between Colombia and Peru, journey past volcanoes in the central Andes, hike around mangroves in the Manglares Churute Ecological Reserve, and hold on tight during a whitewater rafting adventure in the rainforest. You'll also experience the country's rich culture, from meeting indigenous people in the Amazon to dining with locals in the Andes.

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Ecuador

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Quito.

Day 2: Quito

- Take a tour of Quito: Independence Plaza; Government Palace.
- Visit the Church of the Society of Jesus, a Baroque marvel with an ornate interior decked in gold leaf.
- Take an excursion to the equatorial line. If you've ever wanted to stand in both hemispheres at the same time, this is your chance.
- Visit the Intinan Museum, where you'll discover how the Incas determined the location of Earth's center.

Day 3: Quito

- Take a ride through the central Andes on the Train of the Volcanoes. More than five volcanoes surround this railway, which takes travelers from Quito to El Boliche and back. In El Boliche, travelers will disembark for a hike through a mountain cloud forest and a local farm visit.

Day 4: Quito | Tena

- Travel to Tena, a city in the Amazon rainforest and the charming capital of the Napo Province.
- Visit an indigenous Kichwa community and immerse yourself in local culture and customs.

Day 5: Tena

- Enjoy a whitewater rafting excursion.

Day 6: Tena | Riobamba

- Travel to Riobamba via Baños.
- Climb the winding staircase alongside the massive Devil's Cauldron waterfall. Be prepared to get wet!

Day 7: Riobamba | Guayaquil

- Visit a rural community and enjoy lunch with the locals.
- Travel to Guayaquil.
- Take an evening tall ship cruise around the Guayaquil harbor.

Day 8: Guayaquil

- Visit the Manglares Churute Ecological Reserve. Tour the park with an expert local guide, then hike around the reserve's abundant mangroves.
- Travel to the airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 9: Arrive home

Day 9: Puerto López

- Travel via the Ruta del Spondylus to Los Frailes Beach and Puerto López, a small fishing village set against the warm waters of the Pacific that is renowned for its friendly atmosphere and biological diversity. Most famously, it is the headquarters of Ecuador's Machalilla National Park, a former pirate hideout whose reach includes Isla de la Plata just off the coast of Puerto López. As you explore the island's rugged geography, you'll meet a number of creatures known to inhabit the Galapagos, including the blue-footed booby and the albatross. In its coral reef, you'll get the chance to snorkel with a wide, colorful array of fish. Make sure to bring your camera.

Day 10: Puerto López

- Enjoy a boat ride to Machalilla National Park.
- Take an expert-led tour of Isla de la Plata.
- Snorkel off Isla de la Plata.

Day 11: Dos Mangas | Guayaquil

- Take an expert-led tour of Dos Mangas.
- Hike in the coastal rainforest.
- Enjoy lunch with the local community.
- See a handicraft-making workshop.
- Travel to Guayaquil.
- Travel to the airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 12: Arrive home
