

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Switzerland

Day 2: Zurich | Lake Brienz region

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Travel to Bernese Oberland.

Day 3: Lake Brienz region

- Take a guided tour of Berne, the de facto capital of Switzerland nestled 12 miles north of the Bernese Alps. The River Aare flows in a horseshoe pattern around Berne's historic old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here you can snap a photo of the Zytglogge, a medieval clock tower featuring moving puppets, as well as the Münster, a 15th-century Gothic cathedral. At the Einstein House, see where Albert Einstein lived from 1903-1905 while working out his theory of relativity. At the Bear Park, a natural enclosure along the River Aar, keep an eye out for four of the city's most famous inhabitants.
- Visit Bear Park.
- Visit the Einstein House.
- Travel to Emmental.
- Take an expertly guided tour of a cheese dairy and make your own cheese.

Day 4: Lake Brienz region

- Ride the Brienzer Rothorn cable car.
- Visit the Ballenberg Museum.

Day 5: Lake Brienz region

- Participate in a team-building activity at Ropetech Adventure Park.

Day 6: Paris

- Travel via Burgundy to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.

Day 7: Paris

- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides.
- Take an Impressionist painting lesson.

Day 8: Paris

- Visit a Parisian market.
- Time to see more of Paris or
- visit Versailles. Nobody does decadence like Louis XIV, and there's no better testament to this than Versailles. Under the direction of the Sun King, the château that began as a modest hunting lodge exploded into one of the largest palaces on earth. On your excursion to this lavish estate, explore the state apartments of the king and queen and the magnificent Hall of Mirrors. Walk through the meticulously landscaped gardens and marvel at dozens of ornate fountains. Discover why Versailles was more than just a vacation home: Louis XIV hosted his royal court here to reign in their power and prevent their political rise.

Day 9: Paris

- Take a walking tour of Paris: Ile de la Cité.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- Visit Sainte-Chapelle.
- Visit the Louvre.

Day 10: Depart for home
