DAY 1: FLY OVERNIGHT TO FRANCE

DAY 2: PARIS

Welcome to Paris, the City of Light. You're greeted at the airport by your specially trained Language Immersion Program Director, who will be with you throughout your tour. Your first stop in Paris is the Louvre, home of the *Mona Lisa*. From there, take a walking tour along the Seine. As you cross over the river, watch the *bouquinistes* selling old books and postcards, and catch glimpses of the Conciergerie and St. Chapelle from the Pont Neuf. Continue through the Latin Quarter, where the most famous university in Paris, the Sorbonne, was founded in 1253.

DAY 5: NICE

Today's Theme: French Culture, Past and Present—France has played an enormous role in high culture in Europe since the 17th century. Its influence now stretches worldwide, setting trends in fashion, cinema, and cuisine. Nice was the destination of choice for aristocratic families in the 18th century, and continues to be one of France's most popular cities—as you'll discover during today's activities.

- Practice your conversational French in an interactive language lesson that focuses on French cultural traditions.
- Play a round of *pétanque*, a traditional French lawn-bowling game. Side by side with locals, channel your inner French and land your *boule* right beside the *cochonnet*.
- Interact with locals as you compete in a citywide scavenger hunt.

DAY 6: NICE

Today's Theme: French Culinary Traditions— French cuisine is known for its rich, regional specialties such as *crêpes* and cheeses. A French meal typically consists of three to four courses: *hors d'œuvre, plat principal, fromage,* and *dessert.* During today's activities, you'll see that Provençal cuisine is especially well known for its use of olive oil, anchovies, fruits, and vegetables. – Practice food-related vocabulary in an

- interactive language lesson.
- Interact with local vendors during a market challenge and try traditional French foods.
- Try your hand at preparing authentic French food during a cooking class.

DAY 7: NICE

Today's Theme: Daily Life in France— In this bustling European country, rugby is more popular than football and *la bise*, a kiss on both cheeks, is more common than a handshake. Today's your chance to learn what life in France is like, and to see things from a local's perspective.

- Practice your conversational French in an interactive language lesson that focuses on daily life in France.
- Participate in a cultural exchange activity with locals. Whether it's a trivia night, pickup soccer, a student-guided walking tour, or a community project, you'll hear about life in Nice and what it's like to call France home. The locals will want to learn about life in the U.S., so be ready to answer their questions, too!

DAY 8: NICE

Today's Theme: French Art—You've heard of artists such as Vincent van Gogh, Claude Monet, Paul Cézanne, and Pierre Auguste Renoir. These, and countless other artists, called France home for much of their lives. Today you will discover the amazing light, rolling scenery, and unmatched culture that continue to attract artists from around the world.

- Explore Nice's art scene during an interactive art workshop with a local artist.
- Enjoy a homemade dinner with locals, the perfect opportunity to gain unique insight into life in France today.


DAY 9: NICE



France has also been a leader in artistic, literary, and musical movements for centuries, making it arguably one of the most fascinating places to examine pop culture—which you will do today.

- Make your way to Cannes, previously a small fishing village that's now considered a glamorous coastal destination for celebrities due to its annual film festival.
- Stop in the medieval village of Eze, where you can soak up astonishing views of the Mediterranean Sea and French Riviera.
