LANGUAGE IMMERSION THROUGH PERU

10 or 12 days | Lima | Arequipa | Luquina | Puno | Extension to Sacred Valley, Machu Picchu, and Cuzco

What you'll experience on your tour

Each day in Peru is built around a **daily theme** that explores topics you can relate to—like culture, food, and art. You'll improve your Spanish skills, ignite your interest in Peru's indigenous languages, and build your confidence as you discover a new appreciation for the culture.

LANGUAGE LESSONS

You'll learn and practice vocabulary relevant to each day's theme during a lesson led by local language instructors. This is your chance to have guided conversations with fellow students as you prepare for each day's interactive activities.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Learning how to cook in an earth oven like a Peruvian or weaving your own textiles adds authentic cultural richness to your language development. And your specially trained Language Immersion Program Director will be by your side, helping and encouraging the beginning learners while challenging the more advanced students.

INTERACTIONS WITH LOCALS

Conversing with locals while competing in a scavenger hunt or over a home-cooked meal offers you an opportunity to put your new skills to use while learning more about the culture. With each conversation in Spanish, you will gain more confidence in your speaking and listening abilities.

DAY 1: FLY TO PERU

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Lima.

DAY 2: LIMA | AREQUIPA

- Fly from Lima to Arequipa, named “the White City” for its white volcanic stone architecture.
- Enjoy time with a local nonprofit dedicated to creating global citizens through travel, social responsibility, and soccer.

DAY 3: AREQUIPA | COLCA VALLEY

Today’s Theme: Peruvian symbolism

Explore the importance of symbolism in Peruvian culture and build the language confidence to interact with local artisans.

- Visit Santa Catalina Monastery, an active nunnery that feels like a city within a city. Explore its mazelike construction, secret courtyards, and lush gardens.
- Travel to the Colca Valley.
- Participate in a local artisan workshop, where you’ll learn how to weave Peruvian patterns and make *chicha morada*, an authentic Peruvian sweet corn drink.

DAY 4: COLCA VALLEY

Today’s Theme: Incan traditions

Participate in an interactive language lesson on Peru’s indigenous past before experiencing the daily life of rural Peruvians.

- Visit the Colca Canyon, the second deepest canyon in the world and home to the largest bird of prey, the Andean Condor.
- Enjoy lunch cooked in a traditional Peruvian earth oven called *pachamanca* and acquaint yourself with Peru’s spiritual side as you pay your respects to mother earth.
- Enjoy free time with your group.
- Visit a local farm, where you’ll learn how to milk cows and see how yogurt and cheese are made (then taste some, too).
- Participate in a “*pago*”—a shaman ritual led by a local storyteller.

DAY 5: COLCA VALLEY | PUNO | LAKE TITICACA

- Travel to Puno, then take a boat excursion to the Luquina community on the shimmering deep blue Lake Titicaca. In Andean belief, Titicaca is the birthplace of the sun. It’s the largest lake in South America and the highest navigable body of water in the world—almost 12,500 feet above sea level. Enthralling and in many ways singular, Titicaca is the longtime home of highland cultures steeped in the old ways.
- Experience a Luquina community welcome.

DAY 6: LAKE TITICACA

Today’s Theme: Culinary traditions

Practice your conversational Spanish (and food-related terms, very important!) during an interactive language lesson.

- Experience daily life in Peru during your stay in a local family guesthouse—a private building on a local family’s property which provides security, beautiful shore views, and the perfect opportunity for authentic interactions with locals.
- Participate in a Peruvian cooking class.
- Enjoy kayaking on Lake Titicaca.

DAY 7: LAKE TITICACA

Today’s Theme: Community and social entrepreneurship

Learn how rural communities are adapting to a modern world from the locals living it.

- Participate in a Luquina community scavenger hunt.
- Say goodbye to the Luquina community with an evening celebration.

DAY 8: LAKE TITICACA | FLOATING ISLANDS | PUNO

Today’s Theme: Peruvian art

Learn art-related terms and participate in art activities that build on your tour experience.

- Visit Taquile Island, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take part in a weaving demonstration, and walk along old pre-Incan pathways.
- Take part in a weaving demonstration at a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Visit the Uros Floating Islands.
- Return to Puno.

DAY 9: PUNO | LIMA

- Board your flight to Lima.

DAY 10: ARRIVE HOME

DAY 9: PUNO | CUZCO | SACRED VALLEY

- Fly to Cuzco, also known as “the navel of the Earth,” then travel by bus to the Sacred Valley.

DAY 10: SACRED VALLEY | MACHU PICCHU | CUZCO

- Travel by train to Aguas Calientes.
- Visit Machu Picchu, the mist shrouded citadel that evaded Spanish discovery, and has been named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. See remnants of temples and terraces that have yet to reveal the true purpose of Machu Picchu—some believe only an elite Incan priesthood knew of its former existence.

DAY 11: CUZCO | LIMA

- Fly to Lima, Peru’s capital and largest city.
- Visit the Choco Museo and participate in a chocolate workshop.
- Explore Lima on your own.
- Depart for home.

DAY 12: ARRIVE HOME
