

What you'll experience on your tour

Days 1-2: Fly to Australia

- Cross the International Date Line.

Day 3: Sydney

- Welcome to Sydney, a stunning, cosmopolitan city of 4.6 million people that boasts worldclass beaches, iconic architecture, and breathtaking natural wonders.
- Enjoy a bird's-eye view of the city from the observation deck of Sydney Tower. At 1,063 feet, it's the second-tallest building south of the equator.

Day 4: Sydney

- Take a walking tour of Sydney. You will see important landmarks like Sydney Town Hall, and Queen Victoria Building.
- Explore the Hyde Park Barracks Museum, a UNESCO Heritage Site, on a unique tour that brings students face-to-face with Australia's convict heritage.
- Enjoy an "Introduction to Opals in Australia" experience.
- Explore the Sydney Royal Botanical Gardens with an expert local guide, then forage for your own snack, or "bush tucker," with an Aboriginal educator.

Day 5: Sydney

Full day to see more of Sydney or
visit Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park.

Day 6: Sydney | Auckland | Rotorua

- Fly to Auckland.
- Travel to Rotorua, where geothermal activity and Maori culture have made the city a major travel destination.

Day 7: Rotorua

- During your Rotorua Duck Tour, hop on board an amphibious duck boat and explore Rotorua's historic landmarks and natural wonders.
- Participate in an "Introduction to Jade in New Zealand" experience.
- Visit the Agrodome.

Day 8: Rotorua

- A local guide will lead you through your visit to Wai-O-Tapu Thermal Wonderland, where you will learn about geothermal activity and geysers.
- Participate in an immersive experience in a local *Maori* Village where you will explore legends and tribal customs.
- Enjoy Maori song and dance at a traditional hangi dinner.

Day 9: Rotorua | Auckland

- Travel to Auckland.
- Take a tour of Auckland.

Day 10: Auckland | Rarotonga

- Fly to Rarotonga, the largest of the South Pacific's remote Cook Islands.
- During your Cook Island cultural tour, enjoy a traditional lei greeting at the airport with your Tour Director, then get to know the culture and traditions of Rarotonga's residents.
- Transfer to your beachside hotel for a relaxing afternoon and overnight.

Day 11: Rarotonga

- Go snorkeling for an up-close look at colorful fish and coral.
- Free time to see more of Rarotonga

Day 12: Rarotonga | Depart for home

- Visit a school to learn more about local life.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Rarotonga.
- Board your overnight flight for home.
