Day 1: Fly overnight to England

Day 2: London

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17thcentury church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Take a walking tour of London: Piccadilly Circus; Trafalgar Square; The Strand; Covent Garden.
- Visit the National Gallery.

Day 3: London

- Take an expert-led tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Westminster Abbey.
- Visit the Tower of London.
- Attend an evening theater performance.

Day 4: Normandy

- Travel to Dover.

- Visit Dover Castle and WWII Tunnels

Travel by ferry to Calais.

- Day 5: Normandy
- Visit the Caen Memorial.
- Take an expert-led tour of the D-Day beaches of Normandy: American Cemetery; Arromanches; Pointe du Hoc.

Day 6: Paris

- Travel to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Take an expert-led tour of the Louvre, one of Paris's biggest attractions and the most visited museum in the world.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.

Day 7: Paris

- Take an expert-led tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Eiffel Tower.
- Take an expert-led tour of Versailles.
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise.

Day 8: Paris | Milan

- Travel by train to Milan.
- Take a walking tour of Milan: Duomo; Quadrilaterod'Oro. Discover the art, fashion, opera, and gastronomic influences that make this city a cultural hub.

Day 9: Milan | Florence

- Travel by train to Florence.
- Take an expert-led tour of Florence: Ponte
- Vecchio; Gates of Paradise; Duomo.
- Visit the Accademia.

Day 10: Rome

- Travel to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay, explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci," toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.
- Take an expert-led tour of Rome.
- Visit the Colosseum.
- Visit the Roman Forum.

Day 11: Rome

- Take an expert-led tour of Vatican City.
- Visit the Sistine Chapel.
- Visit St. Peter's Basilica.
