





10 days | London | Normandy | Paris

Throughout the tour, you'll visit World War II sites that will help put this major conflict into perspective.

Lessons come to life

On June 6, 1944, American, Canadian, and British forces made history as 156,000 soldiers landed on the heavily fortified coast of Normandy, France. This was one of the largest amphibious military assaults on record, marking the beginning of the Allied invasion of Western Europe.

In honor of D-Day's 80th anniversary in 2024, join students and educators from across the country to explore the historic sites of World War II. You'll gain a new perspective on history and your place in it as you connect with the local community, participate in ceremonies, and rediscover a significant moment that shaped decades of global affairs. Itinerary

June 1-June 10, 2024

Days 1-2 | London

Fly overnight to London and meet your Tour Director at the airport. Visit the Imperial War Museum before having dinner with your group.

Day 3 | London

Take an expert-led tour of London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. At the Churchill War Rooms, explore Great Britain's secret WWII headquarters.

Day 4 | London

At Bletchley Park, home of British code breaking, learn about the role math can play in the world of secrets and spies and how it affected the outcome of World War II. Try your hand at cracking codes in an interactive workshop, and see Colossus, the giant computer that helped break cyphers and shorten the war.

Day 5 | Portsmouth | Normandy

Visit the D-Day Museum in Portsmouth before boarding a ferry to Normandy. Welcome to France!

Day 6 | Normandy

Join thousands for the D-Day 80 ceremonies, a once-in-a-lifetime event that commemorates the Normandy landings. Learn more about the operation known as the beginning of the end of World War II.

Day 7 | Normandy

Continue your tour in Normandy, right where the historic landings happened. Explore the Utah Beach D-Day Museum while experiencing special World War II-themed activities and programming exclusive to EF travelers.

See more of Normandy with your Tour Director, including a visit to the American Cemetery to pay respects to fallen U.S. soldiers. Stop for photo ops at Omaha Beach and Pointe du Hoc. Then, depart for Paris and arrive in time for dinner.

Day 9 | Paris

Experience a ride down the Champs-Élysées, where you'll pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe, followed by a walking tour of the Latin Quarter. Strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower before ending your day with time to explore before dinner.

Day 10 | Depart for home

Travel to the airport and depart for home, returning with a new perspective on world history.
