What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Ecuador

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Quito.

Day 2: Quito

- Take a tour of Quito: Independence Plaza; Government Palace.
- Visit the Church of the Society of Jesus, a Baroque marvel with an ornate interior decked in gold leaf.
- Take an excursion to the equatorial line.
 If you've ever wanted to stand in both hemispheres at the same time, this is your chance.
- Visit the Intiñan Museum, where you'll discover how the Incas determined the location of Earth's center.

Day 3: Quito | Riobamba

- Travel to Riobamba.
- Visit a rural community and enjoy lunch with the locals.

Day 4: Riobamba | Baños

- Travel to Baños.
- Climb the winding staircase alongside the massive Devil's Cauldron waterfall. Be prepared to get wet!
- Try your hand at making traditional Ecuadorian dishes during a cooking class.

Day 5: Baños

- Take a tour of Baños and see the New and Old Cathedrals.
- Learn how melcocha is made and shaped at a local candy workshop.
- Hike through the Baños forest on one of the city's many gorgeous hiking trails.
- Participate in a salsa dance lesson.

Day 6: Baños | Tena

- Transfer to Tena, a city in the Amazon rainforest and the charming capital of the Napo Province. Nicknamed "the cinnamon capital," the city is home to the popular spice ispinku, known to the region since Incan times. Today, the spice is a key ingredient for traditional specialties like mazamorra morada, or purple pudding.
- Hike to a small indigenous village to immerse yourself in local culture and customs.

Day 7: Tena

- Enjoy a whitewater rafting excursion.
- Participate in a traditional Amazon night where you will partake in a shamanistic ritual, enjoy live music, and dance around a bonfire.

Day 8: Tena | Quito

- Travel to Quito.
- Enjoy the opportunity to shop for handmade goods and other souvenirs crafted by the area's local residents at one of the largest craft markets in Quito.
- Transfer to the airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 9: Arrive home

- Take an excursion to Yunguilla, a sustainable development community in the cloud forest.
- Explore reforestation areas now protected by the community.
- Stop for a photo at Pululahua Volcano.

Day 10: Quito

 Experience Ecuador's wealth of volcanic history during an excursion to Cotopaxi National Park with a short hike in the shadow of Cotopaxi volcano.

Day 11: Quito

- Go for a hike alongside the Papallacta river and relax in the area's hot springs.
- Transfer to the airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 12: Arrive home
