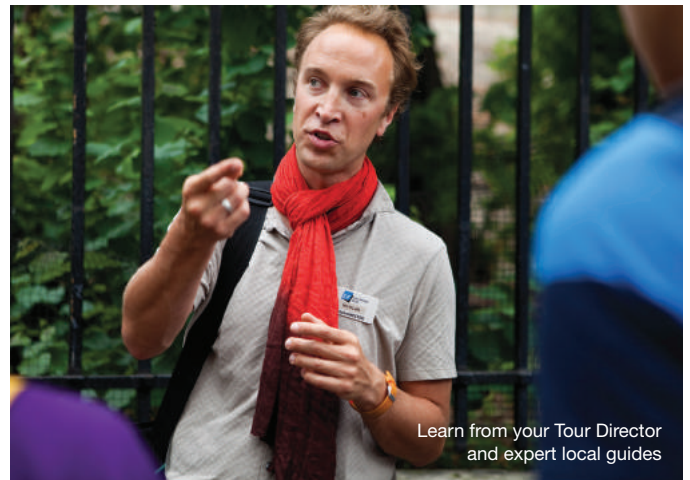

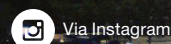
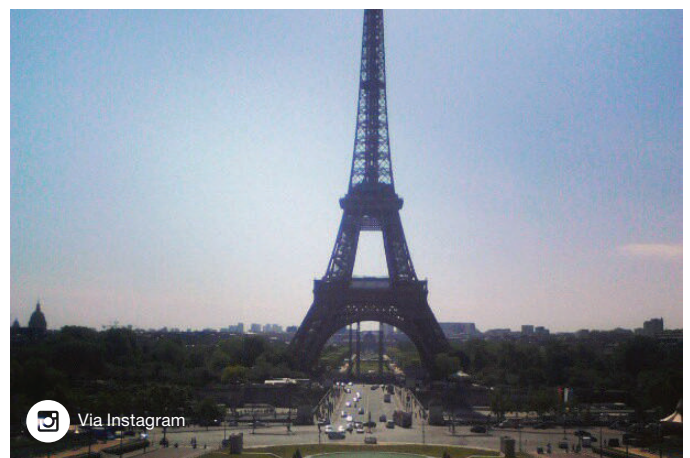

## What you'll experience on your tour

### Day 1: Fly overnight to Italy

#### Day 2: Milan | Venice

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.
- Travel to Venice, the Floating City crisscrossed with romantic bridges, laced with history, and boasting some of the world's finest art and architecture.

#### Day 3: Venice

- Take an expertly guided tour of Venice to see gondolas glide down the Grand Canal before stopping in St. Mark's Square. Look for the golden weathervane, which resembles archangel Gabriel, atop the 323-foot Campanile (Bell Tower).
- Travel by water taxi to the island of Burano, known for its brightly colored homes and lace work.
- Attend a glass-blowing demonstration and watch expert craftsmen spin molten-hot wares.
- Enjoy a gondola ride.

#### Day 4: Venice | Italian lake region | Lucerne

- Travel to Italian lake region.
- Take a cruise on Lake Como.
- Enjoy free time in Bellagio.
- Continue to the Lucerne region, where the majestic Swiss Alps rise behind the shores of Lake Lucerne and provide the stunning backdrop to one of Switzerland's most picturesque cities.

#### Day 5: Lucerne

- During your guided tour of Lucerne you'll see the poignant Lion Monument, or Löwendenkmal, a sandstone statue commemorating the Swiss Guards slain in the 1792 Paris storming of the Tuileries. Follow Lucerne's winding cobbled streets past fairy-tale houses to the Chapel Bridge, or Kapellbrücke. Stroll along this covered bridge, which dates back to medieval days, and admire the colorful murals overhead.
- Time to see more of Lucerne, or
  - ➦ Swiss Alps experience, or
  - ➦ attend a Swiss fondue evening: Savor a taste of Swiss culture as you enjoy a fondue meal—the country's national dish that consists of (delicious) melted cheese and a lot of bread. Then, experience a bit of Swiss tradition in the form of yodeling, folk dances, and Alpine horns. (Just remember to pack your appetite.)

#### Day 6: Lucerne | Paris

- Travel by TGV train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Take a walking tour of the city to get a taste of Parisian style.

#### Day 7: Paris

- On your expertly guided tour of Paris, you'll ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques on your expertly guided tour of the city. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris, or
  - ➦ visit Versailles.

#### Day 8: Paris

- I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, where you'll have the opportunity to glimpse treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.

- Take a walking tour of London.

#### Day 10: London
