From snorkeling in Cahuita National Park to ziplining in a Boquete rainforest, adventure is around every corner.

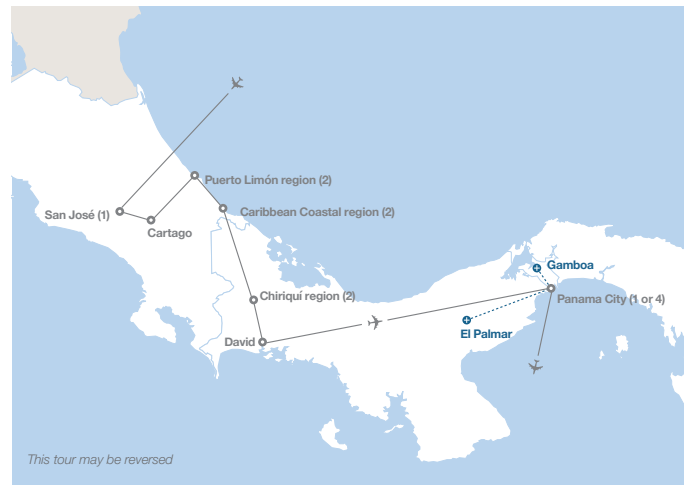

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Costa Rica

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport.

Day 2: San José | Cartago | Puerto Limón region

- Travel to Cartago, once Costa Rica's capital and one of its largest and oldest cities.
- Follow your Tour Director around Cartago for a sightseeing tour, stopping at the Basílica de Nuestra Señora de los Angeles, the Santiago Apóstol Parish Ruins, and the Cartago Municipal Museum.
- Visit the Guayabo National Monument, one of the most important archeological discoveries in Costa Rica. Peek into the past as you explore these pre-Columbian ruins of an ancient city that bustled about 3,000 years ago.
- Travel to the Puerto Limón region, known for its Creole and Black populations, to experience this Afro-Caribbean culture's own languages and ways of life.

Day 3: Puerto Limón region

- Take a guided sightseeing tour of Cahuita National Park, an area with 55,000 acres of protected waters. Bask in the beauty of the Caribbean Coast while you snorkel and peek underwater at 600 acres of living coral reefs.
- Take a Calypso dance lesson.
- Explore on your own or
 - participate in a Limonese cooking class.

Day 4: Puerto Limón region | Caribbean Coastal region

- Travel to the Caribbean Coastal region.
- Visit the Veragua Rainforest Research & Adventure Park, a wondrous 3,400-acre mountain reserve. On a guided tour, be on the look out for snakes, frogs, and other reptiles and take a gondola ride to a breathtaking waterfall.
- Participate in an interactive drumming lesson and performance.

Day 5: Caribbean Coastal region

- Visit the Bri Bri Indigenous Village, a reservation that's home to one of Costa Rica's eight Indigenous tribes, and learn about how they cultivate cacao and turn it into chocolate. (Samples included!)
- Enjoy an outdoor adventure at the stunning Punta Uva beach, where you'll go river kayaking inland from the shore. (Note: Participants must weigh less than 250 lbs.)

Day 6: Caribbean Coastal region | Chiriquí region

- Take a guided sightseeing tour of the Gandoca-Manzanillo Wildlife Refuge, a reserve that contains two extraordinary natural wonders: the only intact mangrove swamp in the Atlantic and a primary lowland small rainforest that's the only one in the region. As you explore the refuge, you might encounter a plethora of wildlife, including crocodiles, tapirs, West Indian manatees, and leatherback sea turtles.
- Travel to the Chiriquí region by crossing the border into Panama by land.

Day 7: Chiriquí region

- Fly through a Boquete rainforest during a ziplining adventure. (Note: Participants must weigh less than 220 lbs.)
- Take in the unique ecosystem of jungle canopies—and awe-inspiring views—as you trek from treetop to treetop amongst a series of hanging bridges. This way-more-than-a-jungle-hike is the perfect opportunity for wildlife spotting and a quick botany lesson.

Day 8: Chiriquí region | David | Panama City

- Explore on your own or
 - enjoy a whitewater rafting experience.
- Travel to David.
- Fly to Panama City.

Day 9: Depart for home

• 3-DAY TOUR EXTENSION

Day 9: Panama City

- Visit the Panamá Viejo Ruins and Museum.
- Take a guided tour of Casco Viejo, Panama City's colorful historic quarter and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Visit the Biomuseo, where eight “devices of wonder” help tell the origin of the Panamanian isthmus and its gigantic impact on the planet's biodiversity.
- Stop for a photo at the Amador Causeway, a famous road that's just the place for an amazing view of the Panama City skyline.

Day 10: Panama City | Gamboa

- Travel to Gamboa.
- Take a boat ride on Gatun Lake and around Monkey Island, home to a variety of monkey species.
- Visit the Miraflores Locks Visitor Center and take an in-depth look at the Panama Canal, one of the most influential engineering projects ever undertaken and one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World.
- Stop for a photo at the Panama Canal Administration Building.

Day 11: Panama City | El Palmar

- Travel to El Palmar.
- Explore on your own or
 - take a surfing lesson at one of Panama's premier surfing locations.
- Participate in a folklore evening with a traditional dance show and authentic Panamanian food.

Day 12: Depart for home
