Day 1: Fly overnight to Greece

Day 2: Athens

 Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Athens and get excited to explore the ancient city named for Athena, the goddess of war and wisdom.

Day 3: Athens

- Take an expert-led tour of Athens, where you'll see the Olympic Stadium that hosted the first modern Olympics in 1896.
- Visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, perhaps the world's greatest architectural feat.
 See the Temple of Athena Nike, which once housed a gold statue of the goddess, her wings clipped to prevent her from deserting the city.
- Visit the Acropolis Museum.
- Take a walking tour of Athens.

Day 4: Athens | Heraklion

- Fly to Heraklion, the largest city on the island of Crete. Considered to be the birthplace of the first European civilization, Crete has a diverse history that inspires its many one-ofa-kind experiences: The island's blend of Minoan, Classical, Byzantine, Venetian, and Turkish cultures is evidenced in the architecture you'll see, the art you'll admire, the food you'll sample, and so much more.
- Enjoy a walking tour with your Tour Director.
 Then, get to know the city even better on an expert-led sightseeing tour around the city.
- Visit Knossos Palace, which was designed, according to Greek mythology, by an Athenian architect named Daedalus who built it so cleverly that it was impossible for anyone to find their way back out of the palace without a guide.
- Visit the state-of-the-art Heraklion Archaeological Museum, one of the most important museums in all of Europe, which holds treasures that date from Neolithic to Roman times.

Day 5: Heraklion | Agios Nikolaos | Spinalonga Island

- Travel to Agios Nikolaos, a picturesque seaside town east of Heraklion. It's home to the ancient lake of Voulismeni, where legends say Greek goddesses Athena and Artemis bathed. Take in the breathtaking sights with your Tour Director.
- Enjoy a short, scenic boat cruise to Spinalonga Island, where you'll spend the day soaking up sunshine and history. Admire the island's Venetian-influenced architecture and famous archaeological fortress while you explore the island.

Day 6: Heraklion | Santorini

- Take an early morning high-speed ferry from Heraklion to the island of Santorini (the municipality of which actually consists of a group of islands, only some of which are inhabited).
- Visit the archaeological site of Akrotiri, a village on the south side of Santorini. Known as the Greek Pompeii, Akrotiri was buried by a volcanic eruption in 1613 BC. However, excavations have revealed evidence of human life dating all the way back to the Neolithic Age.
- Take a walking tour of Santorini's capital, Thira.
 Enjoy free time to explore more of this beautiful
- island on your own.

Day 7: Santorini | Oia Village

- Stop for a photo at the Prophet Elias Monastery, a church built in 1711 on the summit of Mount Profitis Ilias, the highest point on the island.
- Take a walking tour of the coastal village Perissa.
- For lunch, head to the Perissa Black Sand Beach, which is renowned for its deep, dark blue water and black lava sand.
- Travel to Oia Village.
- Situated atop an impressive cliff and filled with beautiful white buildings topped with bright rooftops, Oia is one of the most photographed places in all of Greece. Take in the blue-domed churches and winding paths as you get to know the village on a walking tour.
- Explore more of Oia on your own, and make sure to find the perfect spot to view one of Oia's world-famous sunsets. (Over by Oia Castle is a popular choice, but ask your Tour Director for their favorite ecommendation!)

Day 8: Santorini | Athens

- Take a morning flight back to Athens.
- Choose to have more time to explore Athens or
 attend a Greek evening filled with music and dancing.

Day 9: Depart for home
