What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Ireland

Day 2: Dublin

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Dublin, Ireland's capital city scenically situated between Dun Laoghaire (pronounced "dun leery") and Howth Head's rocky peaks.
- Take a walking tour of Dublin, where you'll experience the capital's culture as you stroll through Grafton Street and the Temple Bar.
- Visit the Little Museum of Dublin.

Day 3: Dublin

- Take an expert-led tour of Dublin: Georgian squares; O'Connell Street; St. Stephen's Green.
- Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral.
- Time to explore Dublin or
 - Song and Dance in Ireland.

Day 4: Dublin | Midlands region

- Cross the Irish Sea by ferry from Dublin to Holyhead.
- Visit a Welsh castle.
- Travel to the Midlands region.

Day 5: Midlands region | Stratford-upon-Avon | London

- Take a tour of Stratford-upon-Avon.
- Visit Shakespeare's Birthplace.
- Visit the Gardens at Anne Hathaway's Cottage.
- Continue on to London, a city of 8 million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own.

Day 6: London

- Take an expert-led tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if scheduled).
- Enjoy an authentic fish and chips dinner.
- Time to see more of London or
- visit Westminster Abbey.

Day 7: London

- Take a walking tour of London: Trafalgar Square; Covent Garden.
- Visit the British Museum.
- Take in a free evening in London.

Day 8: London | Paris

- Travel by Eurostar train to Paris, the City of Light.
- Take a walking tour of Paris.
- Visit the Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.

Day 9: Paris

- Take an expert-led tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or visit Versailles.

Day 10: Depart for home
