What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to France

Day 2: Paris

 Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Paris, the City of Light.

Day 3: Paris

- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower
- Time to see more of Paris or
- visit Versailles.

Day 4: Paris

- Take a walking tour of Paris.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.
- Visit the Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.
- Enjoy a Seine River cruise.

Day 5: Paris | Barcelona

- Travel by TGV train to Barcelona, an art lover's dream city and the place where masters like Miró, Picasso, and Dalí flourished. During your stay you'll explore open-air plazas dotted with avant-garde gems, like the Plaza de Catalunya and Plaza España. Snap photos of the twisting spires of La Sagrada Família and the Magic Fountain of Montjuïc, which astounds with dazzling light and water shows. From atop Montjuïc Hill enjoy panoramic views of the harbor below. Here you'll also find the 1992 Olympic stadium. Marvel at the landscaped greenery and playful Modernist mosaics on your visit to Park Güell. Flower vendors and street performers greet you on your walking tour of the tree-lined Las Ramblas.
- Take a walking tour of Barcelona: Las Ramblas.
- Enjoy a free evening or
 - attend a Barcelona flamenco evening.

Day 6: Barcelona

- Take an expertly guided tour of Barcelona:
 La Sagrada Família; Montjuic Hill; Barrio
 Gótico; and Barcelona Cathedral.
- Visit Park Güell.

Day 7: Carcassonne | Provence

- Take a tour of Carcassonne.
- Take a tour of Nîmes.
- Visit the Nîmes Amphitheater.
- Travel to Provence.

Day 8: French Riviera

- Visit the Pont du Gard.
- Take a tour of Avignon.
- Visit the Palais des Papes.

Day 9: French Riviera | Monaco

- Visit the principality of Monaco.
- Tour a French perfume factory in Eze.

Take a walking tour of Nice. Days 10–11: Pisa | Florence

- See the Leaning Tower of Pisa.
- Continue on to Florence.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Florence.
- Time to see more of Florence or ocreate a fresco.

Days 12-13: Assisi | Rome

- Travel to Rome, a city that integrates its past into the present better than any other. During your stay you'll explore the world's most famous arena, the Colosseum, where you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the Roman Forum marks the former heart of the Roman Empire. Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches there. On your visit to the Vatican City, marvel at Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and look out for the colorful uniforms of the Swiss Guard, protectors of the Vatican City. Before you say "arrivederci", toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City. (Vatican subject to closings on Sundays and holidays.)
- Visit the Basilica of St. Francis.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Vatican City.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Rome.
- Visit the Colosseum.
- Visit the Roman Forum.
- Take a self-guided walking tour of Rome.

Day 14: Depart for home
