What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to Germany

Day 2: Berlin

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Berlin, the vibrant capital of reunified Germany.
- During your walking tour, stroll past cafes, restaurants, and embassies along Unter den Linden, Berlin's most elegant boulevard.

Day 3: Berlin

- Take an expert-led tour of Berlin to discover how the city has been transformed since the Berlin Wall fell in 1989 and now plays a vital role in the European Union.
- Stop for a photo at Checkpoint Charlie, the checkpoint station that once guarded the border between East and West Germany.
- Visit the Topography of Terror Museum, the former headquarters of the Gestapo and the SS during the Nazi Party's control of Germany from 1933 to 1945.
- Time to see more of Berlin or visit Potsdam.

Day 4: Dresden | Prague

- Take a guided walking tour of Dresden.
- Travel to Prague and encounter the legendary beauty of the former capital of the Holy Roman Empire.

Day 5: Prague

- Take an expert-led tour of Prague:
 St. Vitus Cathedral; Wallenstein Palace
 Gardens (April-October); Lennon Wall;
 Charles Bridge.
- During your walking tour of Prague, pass the concert hall where Mozart conducted the premiere of Don Giovanni. Walk the quaint, cobbled streets of the Malá Strana and visit the 13th century Staré Mesto (Old Town) and Market Square. Here you'll see the famous 15th century astronomical clock.

Day 6: Budapest

- Travel through Slovakia to Budapest.
- Enjoy an evening cruise along the Danube River, which divides the land into the old city, Buda, and the newer city, Pest. Listen to stories of Hungarian royalty before the Blue Danube Waltz ushers you into port.

Day 7: Budapest

- From Heroes' Square to the Andrassy Boulevard and the State Opera House, explore Budapest's wealth of culture and beauty during your expertly guided tour of the city.
- Visit Matthias Church, whose intricately tiled roof ornaments the cityscape.
- During your walking tour of Budapest, you'll have the chance to see the towers of Fisherman's Bastion and the impressive arches of the Parliament building up close.
- Visit the House of Terror Museum.

Day 8: Vienna

- Travel to Vienna, residence of the imperial court for six centuries. Vienna is marked with the seal of the powerful Habsburgs, a family who once ruled over half of Europe.
- Enjoy an authentic Wiener Schnitzel dinner.
- Attend an evening of classical music in one of Vienna's many traditional concert halls. Famed musicians such as Mozart, Beethoven, Haydn, Strauss, Brahms, and Schubert all have ties to the Austrian capital.

Day 9: Vienna

- During your expert-led tour of Vienna, you'll visit the Ringstrasse, a series of wide boulevards commissioned by Emperor Franz Joseph in 1857. Continue on to Parliament, the floweradorned City Hall, and the Hofburg, where the Habsburg dynasty once prevailed.
- Visit Schönbrunn Palace, where Marie Antoinette spent her childhood. When the 6-year-old Mozart performed here, he told the future queen of France, "I'll marry you when I'm grown up!"
- Time to see more of Vienna or
 enjoy Viennese waltz dancing.

Day 10: Salzburg | Munich

- Get an introduction to Salzburg with your Tour Director.
- Continue on to Munich, where you'll experience the medieval to the modern.

Day 11: Munich

- Take an expert-led tour of Munich to see the Olympic Stadium, the Residenz, the former home of the Wittelsbach dukes of Bavaria, and Marienplatz's neo-Gothic New City Hall with its famous Glockenspiel.
- Visit Dachau, a WWII Nazi concentration camp built in 1933 and liberated by the Allies in 1945.
 It now serves as a memorial museum.
- Continue past the famous Hofbräuhaus, once the royal brewery of the Kingdom of Bavaria, during your walking tour of the city.

Days 12-13: Heidelberg

- Take an expert-led tour of Heidelberg.
- Visit the Heidelberg Castle wine barrel.
- Time to see more of Heidelberg or
 visit Neckar Valley (April-October).

Day 14: Depart for home
