

#### What you'll experience on your tour

#### Day 1: Fly to Ecuador

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Quito. The Ecuadorian capital is carved into a narrow plateau high above the Andean valleys, beneath the peaks of the Pichincha Volcano.

#### Day 2: Quito

- Take a tour of Quito: Independence Plaza; Government Palace.
- Visit the Compañía de Jesús church.
- Travel to the equatorial line. If you've ever wanted to stand in both hemispheres at the same time, this is your chance.
- Visit the Intiñan Museum, where you'll discover how the Incas determined the middle of the Earth.

#### Day 3: Quito | Baltra Island | North Seymour Island

- Fly to Baltra Island, where you'll board the Galápagos Legend cruise ship and set off for North Seymour Island.
- Explore North Seymour Island, keeping an eye out for magnificent frigatebirds, blue-footed boobies, sea lions, and swallow-tailed gulls as you hike and snorkel.
- Return to the cruise ship for the night.

#### Day 4: Bartolomé Island | Santiago Island

- Travel by cruise ship to Bartolomé Island. This islet is known for its gorgeous panoramic views and is home to the distinctive Pinnacle Rock, a volcanic cone that's made up of many thin layers of basalt. This unique locale has often been likened to a lunar landscape.
- Head to Sullivan Bay, an area that is located at the southeastern portion of Santiago Island and is covered in solidified lava flows known as pahoehoe.
- Get to know the island better as you hike, snorkel, and enjoy beach time. If you're lucky, you might end up face-to-face with wildlife like the famous Galápagos penguins.
- Get a good night's sleep aboard the cruise

#### Day 5: San Cristóbal Island

- Travel by cruise ship to San Cristóbal Island.
- Hike up one of the island's tuff cones-a.k.a volcanic structures formed when boiling lava meets a cold ocean. From this vantage point, you might be able to see all three of the Galápagos Islands' booby species (the bluefoot, red-foot, and Nazca) in the same place.
- Go snorkeling or kayaking with your group.
- Head to Cerro Brujo, a white sand beach with an impressive volcanic landscape, via an inflatable, motorized dinghy known as a panga. During your brief ride, you'll get to take in the stunning cliffs of Sorcerer's Hill.
- Enjoy a nature walk.
- Go snorkeling again, looking out for animals like sea lions, marine iguanas, and sea turtles.
- Return to the cruise ship for your final night at sea.

#### Day 6: San Cristóbal Island | Quito

- Visit the Cerro Colorado Tortoise Reserve in the highlands of San Cristóbal. While here, you'll visit the tortoise breeding center to witness the archipelago's most iconic creature in its various life stages. You'll also have free time to explore the surrounding town.
- Fly back to Quito.

#### Day 7: Quito | Depart for home

- Visit the market town of Otavalo. Surrounded by the Imbabura, Cotacachi, and Mojanda volcanoes, Otavalo is a small farming town known for its textiles. You'll have the opportunity to shop for handmade goods and other souvenirs crafted by the area's local residents at one of the largest craft markets in the country. And don't think that handicrafts are the only thing you will find here—you can purchase anything from musical instruments to a meal. Plus, the market offers a unique glimpse into traditional Andean culture, as locals have frequented the markets for hundreds of years.
- Learn how local families create ponchos during a demonstration of the craft.
- Enjoy a waterfall hike at Peguche Waterfall.
- Travel to the airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 8: Arrive home
